Who Are We?

Radio Adelaide 101.5fm broadcasts to Adelaide and the world from our high profile street-front studios on North Terrace in Adelaide's CBD. Our station is powered by more than 400 volunteers, supported by skilled and dedicated staff. A not for profit community radio station, we are part of the University of Adelaide and connected to a national network of over 360 independent, local stations. We're also a Registered Training Organisation, providing nationally accredited training and we offer professional media production services to the broader community. Independent research conducted in 2008 shows we have a loyal listener base of 88,000 weekly listeners and more than 155,000 total listeners to our FM service. In the last 12 months alone, we have been recognised with 14 awards, including a Silver Medal at the New York Festivals, the 2008 Archbishop of Adelaide Media Citation, and national awards for Best Music Program, Excellence in Ethic and Multicultural Programming and Excellence in Training.

We Meet the Diverse Needs of Our Community

Our programming is wide-ranging and provides a real alternative to mainstream radio, with diverse voices, music, current affairs and talk. Adelaide's best alternative current affairs coverage can be heard on *Breakfast With Peter Godfrey* and *The Wire*, broadcast nationally each weekday afternoon. Dozens of communities gain access to the airwaves through their own programs on Radio Adelaide and hundreds more through interviews and exposure on our shows.

We've got the Arts Covered

Dedicated arts broadcasters, we provide a comprehensive coverage with specialist programs such as *Arts Breakfast* and *Writers Radio*, alongside daily coverage during *Breakfast* and *The Range*. Music on Radio Adelaide is independent and diverse; with specialist knowledge and new sounds. *Public Domain* broadcasts outstanding public talks given in Adelaide by leading national and international thinkers and activists.

We Provide Quality Training

As a Registered Training Organisation we provide Certificate II - IV level training in Media and Music Industry Skills for our volunteers and a range of community groups, schools and other organisations. We also provide tertiary courses for both the Universities of Adelaide and South Australia (Media and Journalism). Our training partners include schools, Music SA, community broadcasters around South Australia and CAAMA, the Central Australian Aboriginal Media Association. Hundreds of Radio Adelaide graduates work in all areas of Australian media.
